Call for Teacher Applicants!

“This camp has been a great experience. Thank you!” commented a camper on the last day of the Summer 2011 camp. The campers, teachers, instructors, and staff of the last two years have had a great experience learning about computer hardware, programming with Alice, and designing and building Lego robots.

We are now looking for four teachers to participate in the 2013 G2CS camp both as educators and learners. At the end of the camp, G2CS teachers will be designated as lead teachers for their school districts, bringing the new curriculum to their peers in the classrooms.

The camp will run from June 17th through July 12th. The teachers will serve at one week of the camp. The day starts at 9 am and ends at 4 pm. Each week will include one or two field trips. Teachers are also expected to attend:

May	Staff Orientation
June 16 th	Parent/Student Orientation
June	Overnight Field Trip
July 12 th	Closing Banquet
TBA	Winter Camp Reunion

Teachers will receive a stipend of \$1,000 for their assigned week of camp and for their participation in the other events mentioned above.

Since a major objective of the project is to encourage development of computer science curriculum in middle schools, we will pay \$1,000 for the G2CS teachers to lead two “Resource Sharing Sessions” where they will present their material to at least four other teachers in their school district (two teachers per session). The first resource session must be completed and the report submitted by December 31, 2013, and the second one must be completed and the report submitted by June 15, 2014.
